



Australia by Design Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival

Dinner

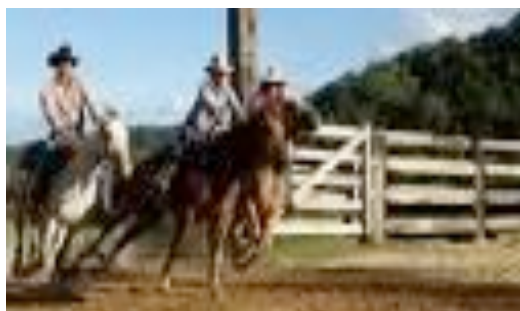

Dinner

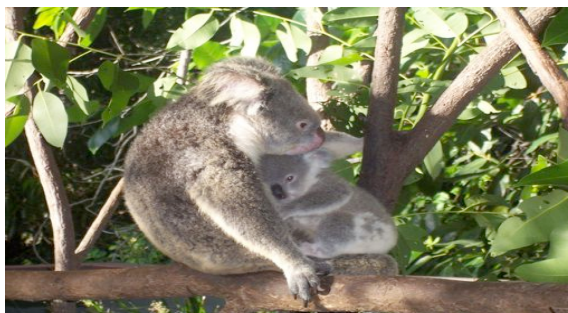
