Day 1

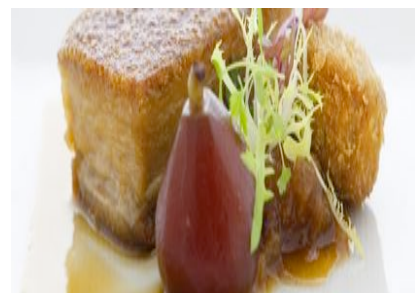


Morning Activity

Dinner

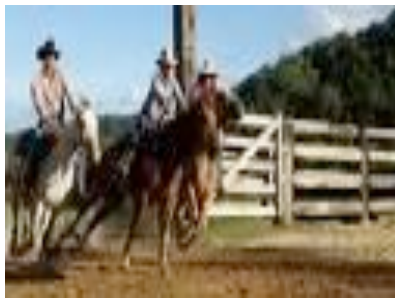

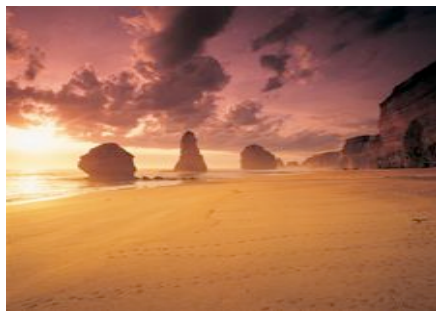
Day 18
