### Day 1

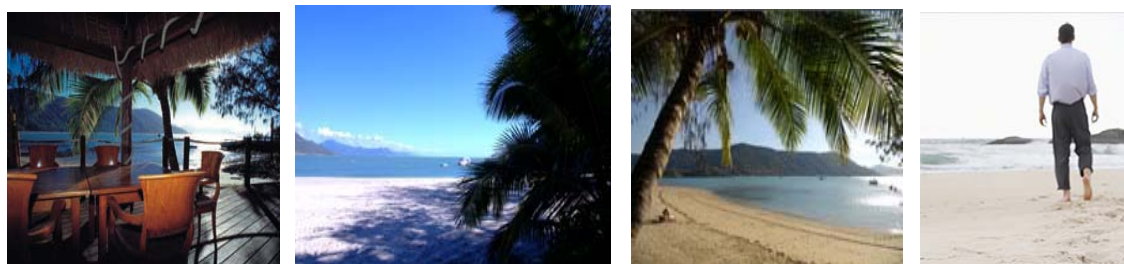
#### *Arrival*
